Poland, Gilbert began to study violin at the Frederik Chopin School of Music and she made her orchestral solo debut at the age of fifteen. She finished her Bachelor's degree in Violin Performance and Masters in Music in Music Education at Silesia University in Poland.

A recipient of a full scholarship, Gilbert traveled to the United States to study with Dr. Ernest Salem at California State University, Fullerton for her Masters Degree in Violin performance. She was the CSUF Orchestra Concertmaster and awarded the Orchestra Conducting Scholarship.

An expert in violin pedagogy, Beata Gilbert began designing and illustrating a teaching book in 2007. The Violin Course for Young Beginners. This complete 3-parts course with its Lesson Book, Work Book and Log Book is a product of her passion for helping children to have a better and more productive lesson while learning the violin. She has implemented her kid-friendly course into her own teaching with great success and looks forward to helping other violin instructors and their students reach their goals.

Currently besides performing, she operates a successful independent violin studio in Anaheim Hills as well as being part time faculty, violin instructor and chamber orchestra conductor at Santa Ana College.

If you have seniors in your studio who are going to be Music Majors for Fall 2018, they can apply for the scholarship from MTAC

Application Deadline April 15, 2018, postmark)

Guidelines:

- Student must accepted as a music major at a two or four-year college, university, or conservatory
- 2. Double majors will **NOT** be considered.
- 3. In Certificate of Merit, the recipient must have completed successfully, including the senior year. **Level 9** for piano and other instruments and **Level 6** for voice.
 - Scholarship winners and their teachers will be notified of their award after Board approval at the May meeting. (2018)
- 5. Scholarship checks will be sent to the student upon written verification of enrollment as a music major by the college, university, or conservatory.
- 6. The deadline for claiming scholarship money is **October 15, 2018**.

Certificate of Merit testing is over. I wish to thank all of the teachers and students that worked so hard, to make our CM a success. I especially want to thank the Site Chairs, Door Monitor Chairs and especially the Hostesses who provided the food that kept our evaluators happy.

CM results will be available online March 8 for teachers only. Parents will be able to see the results March 14. This gives teachers time to check their scores for any error before the parent sees them.

CM Evaluation forms will be returned to the teachers at the Branch meeting on March 14. Evaluations not picked up will be sent to 6 different locations by city. If you are not able to attend the meeting, look for the location nearest you. The list of locations can be found in this newsletter.

Theory exams will be returned at the Branch meeting on April 4. Exams not picked up will be sent to the same locations as the evaluation forms were sent to in March.

Testing is over, but CM is not. We still have our Honors Festival March 25. The Festival is a celebration for the students that received 80% or above in theory, and good to excellent in Sight Reading, Technique, and Repertoire. Less than 300 students out of 1500 tested qualified. Teachers, be sure to e-mail your Branch Honors application before the deadline, March 12.

Students that qualified for a convention recital, will have the privilege of playing at the MTAC Convention in Anaheim this summer. Teachers must confirm and parents must pay through their Parent Portal by April 15.

High school students that were unable to make their scheduled CM Evaluation due to illness or to a school commitment, may apply for the CM make-up. The application form can be found under

"Resources" on the Teacher Portal.

Download the form, fill it out. Mail the form along with a check payable to MTACOC for the amount of \$70 to Judi Moore, CM Chair.
