Every March marks the end of Certificate of Merit evaluations. However, this year is different from any other. Our Branch is one of the fortunate ones. We were able to complete our evaluations and theory testing before the "stay at home" order was enforced. Other Branches are still waiting for the State to lift the ban.

Because many Branches have not been able to conduct their evaluations, it has also affected us. First, we cannot release the theory exams until all testing is completed throughout the State. Second, the MTAC State offices are closed until further notice. Therefore, we cannot receive our State Honors Seals until they reopen. Third, C.M. Make-up Evaluations cannot be scheduled until all testing is completed. In other words, we are in limbo until further notice.
